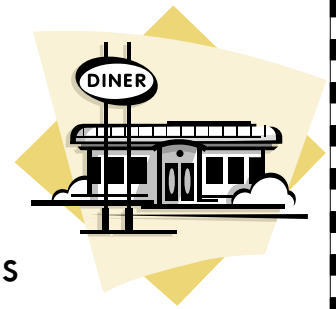


# Personal Dictionary

## Menu

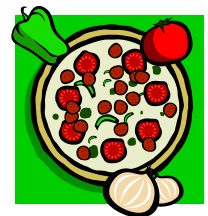


Complete **ONE** of the following items using the words in your personal dictionaries:



**"As-SORT-ed appetizers" \$35 words:** Create an open sort by organizing your words into two or more categories of your own choosing. The only rule is that the categories must be related to their usage or meaning **NOT** categories like "Words with 6 letters" or "Words that start with G". Write a brief explanation of why you picked those categories and why the words fit into those categories. **THINK OUTSIDE THE BOX!**

**"Puzzle Pizza" \$30 words:** Create an original crossword puzzle using at least 30 words. Your clues must be original sentences unrelated to the context of your source, but they must use the exact connotation used in your book. Your answers must also be filled in. Should use online puzzle program.



**"Window-pane Wedge Salad" \$25 words:**



Create a window pane for 25 of your words. Include: word, definition, original sentence and colored illustration of your sentence. Your words must also be color-coded by part of speech: nouns=red; verbs=blue; adjectives=green; adverbs=purple; all others=orange.



**"Short Stack Story" \$20 words:** Write an original short story featuring 20 of your words using them in the same connotation as your source. This must be a complete, cohesive tale (neither ridiculous nor silly).  
Maximum: 26 lines

**"Omelet of Origins" \$15 words:**

Investigate the origins of 15 of your words. Break them down into prefixes, suffixed and root words, and define each part. Also indicate the language of origin for each of the words.



**"Greasy Spoon Graphics" \$10 words:** Create an original comic strip/graphic novella using at least 10 of your words. This menu item requires at least some artistic ability because your images need to be neat and meaningful. Minimum of 12 distinct cells (boxes) with dialogue and/or narration

**"Quizzing Quesadilla" \$5 words:** Create a context clues quiz by writing a mini-passage or paragraph FOR EACH WORD using your words in contexts.

Then write a multiple choice question in which the reader must use context clues to figure out the meaning of your word. You will end up with 5 paragraphs and 5 questions.



**"Banana Split Bonus":** You may get a 5 point bonus for arranging at least 20 of your words into a word cloud, such as Wordle, and printing it out.
